Baptisms: An initial appointment with one of the Priests is required before attending a session.

In the first three chapters of Mark, Jesus is at the beginning of his ministry, and has been curing people of their ailments and casting out demons - in effect "striking at the heel" of Satan (Genesis 3:15). But in doing so, he has also been scandalizing and alarming the Scribes and Pharisees. In this passage Jesus faces opposition, hostility and accusations, with some doubting his sanity, and other saying he is a demon that casts out other demons. Jesus points out the flaw in their logic: "How can Satan cast out Satan?" Christ's words about the "eternal sin" of blaspheming against the Holy Spirit have been the sources of much discussion, with the Catechism of the Catholic Church stating about this passage: "There are no limits to the mercy of God, but anyone who deliberately refuses to accept His mercy by repenting, rejects the forgiveness of his sins and the salvation offered by the Holy Spirit. Such hardness of heart can lead to final impenitence and eternal loss (CCC 1864)."

- How do people continue to doubt and question Jesus to-
- In your own understanding, is the Eucharist a thing/object (i.e. the host) or an action, or much more than that namely the true Presence of a Person? How have you understanding? Has it grown and come to this changed?
- How has your own life been taken, blessed, broken and shared as a Eucharistic child of God.
