"Lest we forget" is a phrase commonly used in war remembrance services and commemorative occasions in English speaking countries, usually connected to the British Empire, like Canada. This poem was written by Rudyard Kipling called "Recessional". 'God of our fathers, known of old, Lord of our far flung battle line, Beneath whose awful hand we hold, Dominion over palm and pine - Lord God of Hosts, be with us yet, Lest we forget—lest we forget!

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: First Reading: 1 Kings 17.10-16

Second Reading: Hebrews 9.24-28 Gospel: Mark 12.38-44

Once again Jesus warns his listeners not to judge by words and pious practices, but to look at the actions that reveal the state of one's heart. The contrast couldn't have been greater: scribes, who were presumed to be holy and loved by God, with a widow whose poverty would be regarded by some in that time and place as a curse from God. Jesus learns and teaches from what he observes in the human heart and perceives in the human spirit; let this be a lesson to us all.

- What part of this passage touches you the most?
- If Jesus came today, who would he criticize in the same way as he does the scribes in this passage?
- Recall a situation where you felt compelled to give God all you had. (Reflection: Diocese of Saskatoon)
