Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: First Reading: Genesis 2.7ab, 15, 18-24 Second Reading: Hebrews 2.9-11

Second Reading: Hebrews 2.9

Gospel: Mark 10.2-16

This discussion on divorce in Mark is found in all three synoptic Gospels (Matthew, Mark and Luke). Jesus upholds the original divine plan of the indissolubility of marriage, citing the Mosaic exception as a concession to human weakness. In typical Gospel of Mark fashion, Jesus follows this up by privately instructing the disciples. Immediately following this heavy discussion Jesus gives the example of a child.
